A partnership with Jubilee BEST Robotics is more than just an innovative way to reach the best and brightest students in our community. WHAT: The Jubilee BEST Robotics program has been in existence for over 16 years and is committed to education and workforce development. Jubilee BEST is a community based non-profit organization and has grown into the largest BEST program in the nation. Jubilee BEST gained national recognition recently when three local schools were invited to the White House where they participated in the Presidential Science Fair.
